Selection of projects for the period 2025-2027

The delegations have reached an understanding that due to the success of the Joint Calls a fifth call for proposals shall be envisaged for spring 2026. The selection meeting is planned in the second half of 2026. The details will be agreed upon by e-mail. The 5th call shall be open to further "Participants" in the Danube region but also to other interested countries joining the programme.
